- Administer high quality radiation therapy as prescribed by the physician.
- ExacTrac experience is a plus
- Be able to work proficiently utilizing the latest treatment techniques including 3D conformal, IMRT, IGRT and SRS/SBRT
- Verify prescribed treatment dose before each treatment; verify fields to be treated, and angles to be used
- Assure placement of protective devices, to shield otherwise healthy exposed tissue of patients
- Simulates patients using simulator, CT scanner or other devices to accurately localize treatment areas
- Display professional conduct essential to the well-being of the radiation oncology patient
- Maintain accurate and detailed treatment chart documentation
- Observe the clinical progress of the patient, use clinical decision-making skills to recognize and report any signs of complications
- Adhere to radiation safety procedure protocol
- Perform machine safety checks; know safe limits of equipment operations, and report abnormalities or inconsistencies to the Center Leader
- Work closely with the Radiation Oncologist and the therapy team in the preparation of a treatment plan
- Adhere to the Radiation Therapist Code of Ethics
